

Project – PICT Project Evaluation

The international Steering Group required a rolling formative and summative evaluation of their three-year Leonardo da Vinci funded PICT Project (Planning Inclusion of Clients through e-Training), to help shape its development.



Key Actions

Pulse Regeneration worked with the partners from Belgium, Greece, Hungary and the UK to evaluate the project's targets, achievements, partnership working, and to develop standardised monitoring techniques. The approach included interactive presentations at Transnational Steering Committee Meetings, attendance at UK Consultative Committee meetings to observe the learning process with local community members, as well as ongoing dialogue with project partners. The Interim and Final reports made key recommendations for potential improvements, and developed a future strategy.

- Achievable suggestions for how to better engage with local community members
- Development of a strategy for how to maintain the lessons learnt to inform and shape future projects
