

## Project – Social Enterprise Course

Cheshire & Warrington Social Enterprise Partnership (CWSEP) were aware of the value of the social economy, and sought to provide tailored training to social enterprises to assist the sector's growth.



### Key Actions

Pulse Regeneration developed and delivered a comprehensive Social Enterprise training course, including five workshops; legal issues, board development, finances, marketing, and business planning. Each workshop was delivered over a three-month period at various venues, each at different times. Workshops were fully interactive, utilising group discussions and exercises to maximise input and ensure full understanding.
